

RIGGERS GET THEIR SEA LEGS IN NORWAY

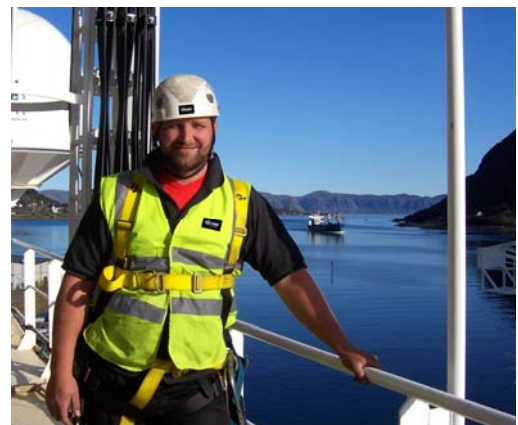
